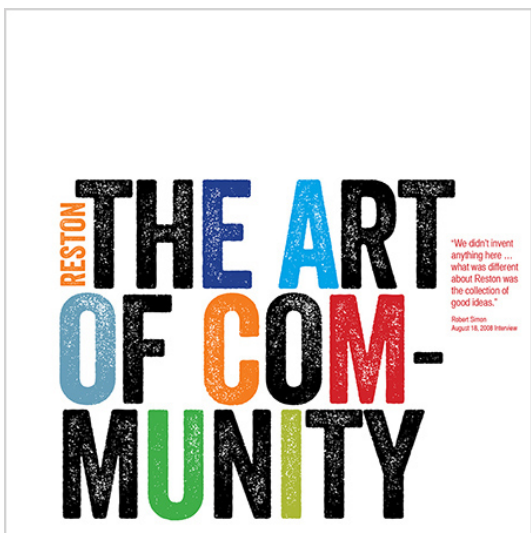


## **7th** Farewell to *A Bird in the Hand*
